

Edward Shield Competition - 4/10/1932

(As recorded in the 1st Observatory Wold Cub Pack Log Book)



The Pack met at the Scout Hall at 8am. After the necessary preparations, we marched down to the station and boarded a train for Wynberg.

Arriving at Wynberg we alighted. And marched up to Wynberg Camp where the competition was to be held.

There we found a suitable site and prepared a rough shelter with some branches and leaves found in the neighbourhood, to shelter the

Pack from the stiff North West wind which was blowing at the time.

At 10am sharp the competition started. From then until 3.30pm with the exception of an hour allowed for lunch we kept hard at it.

At 3.30pm it started to drizzle, and further competitions were concluded.

A kind resident nearby allowed all the Cubs and Cubbers to shelter in her house, until the points were totalled to discover the winner.

After an anxious half hour we were informed that the 1st Clifton were the winners; 1st Claremont 2nd and 1st Observatory 3rd.

The winner was congratulated and thus the Edward Shield Competition drew to an end. The packs then dispersed.
